# Monitoring of Endemic and Exotic Equine Diseases

- NEVA has initiated a monitoring system in the Netherlands
- SRP (Horse Industry Association) and Ministry of Agriculture > financial support
- Dutch Health Organization > monitoring



# Which infectious diseases are evident!

- African horse sickness; Vesiculaire Stomatitis en Rabies
- Endemic diseases in the Netherlands: equine herpes (EHV-1)en (EHV-4) en influenza
- Exotische virale ziekten: West Nile virus (WNV); African horse sickness (AHS); Eastern equine encephalitis (EEE); Western equine encephalitis (WEE); Venezuelan equine encephalitis (VEE); Equine infectious anemia (EIA)
