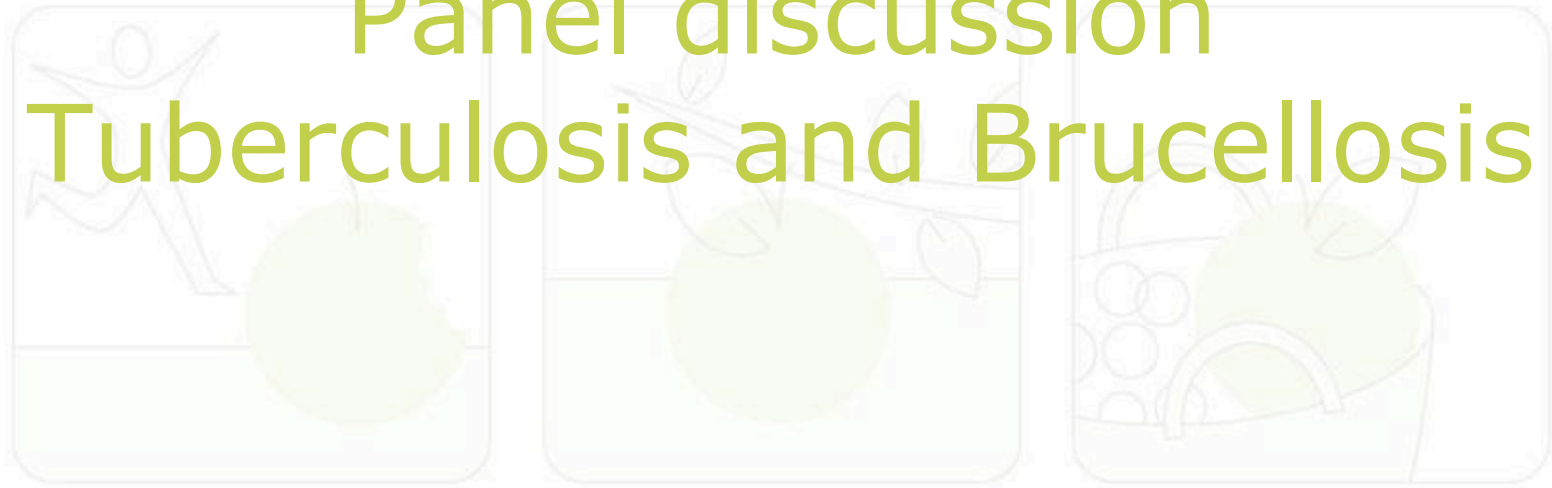




Panel discussion Tuberculosis and Brucellosis



Options

- Continue current palpation and incision procedures
- Delete palpation and incision procedures for normal carcasses only
- Delete palpation and incision procedures for normal carcasses from controlled housing farms only

Consequences of proposed options

- EFSA concludes, that when visual inspection is applied only to normal carcasses, and palpation and incision in case of abnormalities is carried out, the consequences for the control of Tuberculosis and Brucellosis, will be limited
