Article II.2.1-5: Supplementary animal health requirements for operators of slaughterhouses receiving kept bovine animals from another Member State

FVE suggests to delete point 3. Animals should not be allowed coming from another MS or zone without disease-free status or approved eradication programs regarding Bluetongue (or IBR) to go to slaughterhouses in MS or zones with disease-free status.
